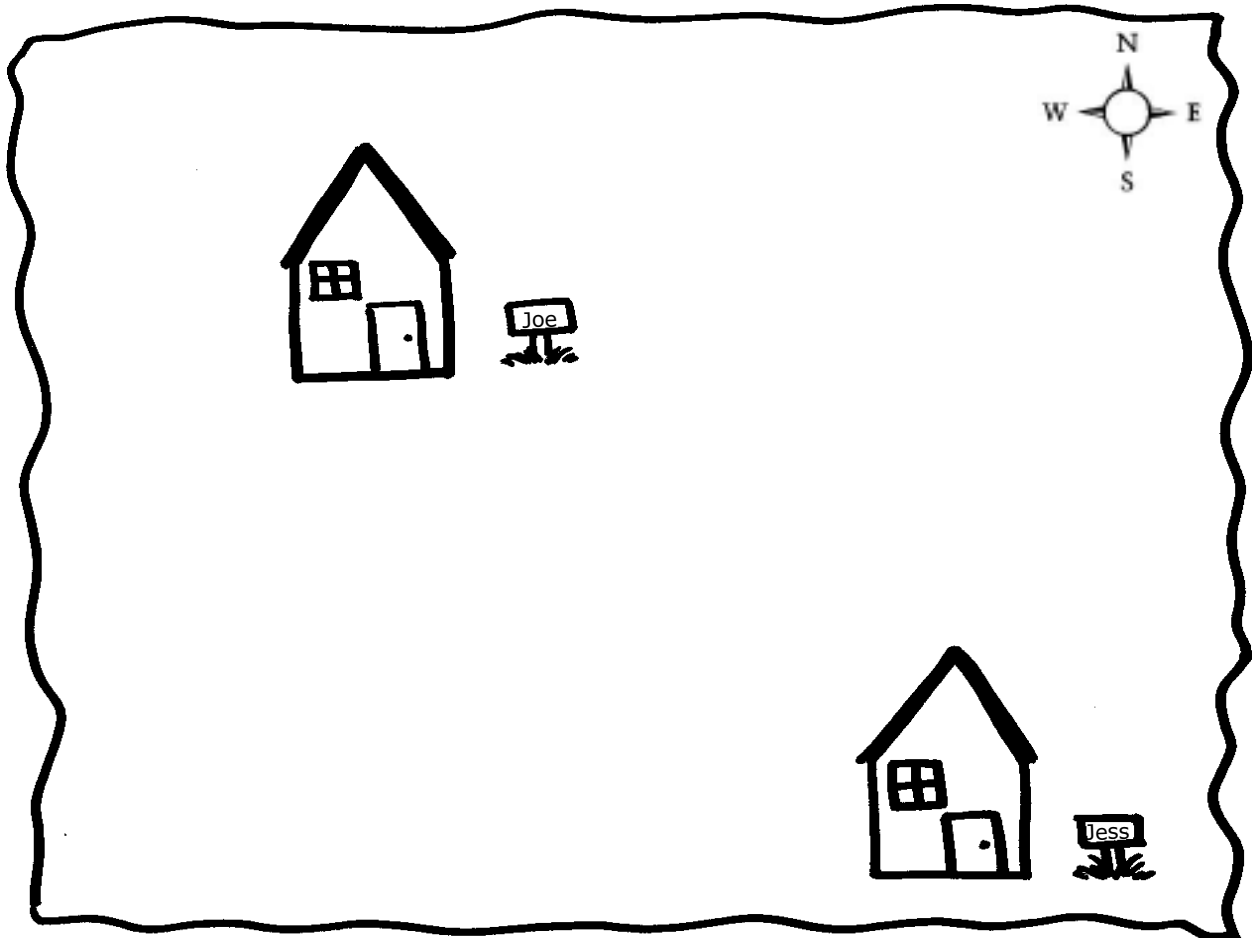


Old Joe and the Carpenter— A Story from Appalachia USA

ACTIVITY SHEET #1



Follow these mapping instructions to picture the end of the story.

1. The Appalachian region is named after its mountains. Draw a mountain range across the northern part of the map.
2. For hundreds of years, the people of Appalachia have farmed. Draw a barn west of each house.
3. Draw the calf that caused the argument, grazing south of Jess's barn.
4. Draw the creek that Jess plowed and flooded, from the northeast corner to the southwest corner of the map.
5. Draw Joe's woodpile south of his barn.
6. Draw the bridge the carpenter built, north of Jess's barn and east of Joe's house.
7. Draw Joe and Jess shaking hands, forgiving each other, west of the bridge.
